Year 3 – 6

Science Day!

KS2 pupils had a fantastic Science Day exploring key physics concepts linked to the TITANIC through hands-on investigations. Children experimented the aerodynamics of rocket flares, testing how shape affects movement through air, and explored the up thrust of water through practical challenges. They also investigated **floating and sinking**, linking this to **water density** and making predictions before testing their ideas. The day was full of curiosity, teamwork and scientific thinking, bringing physics to life in an engaging and memorable way.
